

O R D I N A N C E

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Elloree deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens of said Town to restrict the use of bicycles in the downtown area of the town, and

WHEREAS, the Council and Mayor deem said restriction to be in the best interest of the public,

NOW, THEREFORE be it ordained by the City Council of the Town of Elloree, this 1st day of August, 1983, that it shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle, tricycle, wagon, moped or any other type of wheeled vehicle on the sidewalks of the Town of Elloree in the area running from Railroad Avenue to Lexington Street. Persons who are handicapped or otherwise impaired are specifically excluded from this Ordinance.

The violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.
