Whereas, the Town Council of Ellore deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the said town to name the Eastern Bluebird the town bird of Ellore.

Whereas, the Council and Mayor deem it in the best interest of the citizens to protect all species of birds as long as there are no health hazards to the citizens of the town..

Now, **Therefore be it ordained** by the Town Council of Ellore, this 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 2005, that Town of Ellore recognizes the town bird of Ellore as the Eastern Bluebird. Furthermore, all birds are to be protected from harm as long as they do not present a health hazard as may be deemed by local or state health officials.
