Whereas, the Town Council of Elloree deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the said town to regulate garage sales, yard sales.

Whereas, the Council and Mayor deem the above regulation to be in the best interest of the public,

Now, therefore be it ordained by the Town Council of Elloree, this 7th day of February 2005 that ORDINANCE 98-014 section 24 be amended to read as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for anyone to conduct a garage/yard sale in the Town of Elloree without first obtaining a permit from the town clerk/treasurer for each sale. The permit must be posted in a conspicuous location the day of the sale. The permit fee is \$5.00 per each sale day. The maximum period for each sale is (2) consecutive days, not to include Sunday. The maximum number of permits is (2) two per year per family unit, location, lot, or premises. Furthermore it is unlawful to post any yard sale signs on public right of way or utility poles.

Section 2: Penalty for failure to obtain permit and or obey sign posting regulations: A town official and/or law enforcement officer may issue a warning to any resident that can show they have lived in the town limits for less than one calendar year of the date of the sale. At their earliest convenience they should come into to the town hall to obtain a yard sale permit. For residents residing longer than one year a warning may be issued for one year from the date the ordinance was enacted. The resident should come in and obtain a permit after being warned. Failure to obtain a permit after the warning clause of the ordinance or ignoring the ordinance will result in a fine of \$100 in addition to any surcharges levied by the town, county, or state.

Section 3: The Town in conjunction with all town merchants or by town sponsorship allocates one day a year to have a town wide yard sale where any resident may have a yard sale on that day with no permit. This day does not go against the 2 (2) permitted days. If the event is merchant sponsored it must be requested in front of the town council in writing 60 days before the event. The event must be passed by council resolution each year it is requested. If there is no resolution passed no town wide yard sale may take place.
