IV. Water Commission Report

Cole Dantzler presented the monthly report for the Elloree Water System. There were 89 work orders for November and 643 Customers billed. Water loss was at 18% for the month. The water and waste water facilities and Bacti were in compliance with DHEC for the month. Ms. Dantzler stated the next monthly meeting would be December 12, 2017 at 6:00PM.
