

**Town Council Meeting Minutes**

**I. Call to Order**

Mayor Stan Busch called the meeting to order at 5:31Pm.

**II. Opening Prayer**

Council Member Mike Fanning provided the Invocation.

**III. Approval of Minutes**

Council Member Milt Felder made a motion to accept the minutes from April 10, 2017 and May 8, 2017. Council Member Mike Fanning seconded the motion. All were in Favor.

**IV. Special Guest or Public Requests or Comments for Mayor or Council**

Claudette Pauling requested to be on the agenda but did not show for the meeting.

**V. Water Commission Report**

Cole Dantzler presented the monthly report for the Ellore Water System. There were 108 work orders for May and 644 Customers billed. Water loss was at 32% for the month. The water and waste water facilities and Bacti were in compliance with DHEC for the month. Ms. Dantzler stated the next monthly meeting would be June

13, 2017 at 6:00PM. A Public Hearing will be held on June 13, 2017 at 5:30PM to hear the 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading of the 2017/2018 Budget.

**VI. Police Report**

Due to the flooding situation in Town Hall we are unable to retrieve documents needed for the Police Report.

**VII. Clerk/Treasurer Report**

Ms. Robin Martin presented the Monthly clerk/treasurer reports for April and May 2017. The Police Fines Report for the Month of April, showed the following totals:

- Total Fines Collected: \$1305.50
- State Treasurer: \$790.15
- Victims Asst. Fund: 87.32
- Remaining: \$428.03 (to be placed in savings)

Total fines collected for the month of May are as follows:

- Total Collected: \$2,017.00
- State Treasurer: \$1,068.08
- Victims Asst. Fund: \$133.18
- Remaining: \$615.74 (to be placed in savings)

Council Member Mike Fanning made a motion to approve the Clerk/Treasurer Report and Council Member Harold Void seconded the motion. All were in favor.

**VIII. Old Business**

Mayor Stan Busch stated that the Audit was going well.

Mayor Busch stated the roof had been repaired to Town Hall. He also stated the Servo Pro will be in Town Hall from Wednesday thru Friday removing the carpet and tile in the court room along with the offices attached to court room. Asbestos was found there during the cleaning of Town Hall after the flood.

Mayor Busch stated that the new shingles would be arriving on June 30, 2017 for the Depot. Fred Gaskins was contracted to install the shingles.

Ms. Sarah Ann Parler asked the Mayor and Council who is responsible for any damage done while the new gas lines were being run. Ms. Parlor stated that the historical sign in front of the Snider House had been damaged. Mayor Busch said that everything would be repaired after all lines were completed. He also stated that DPU would be repairing the roads and sidewalks along with any other damage sustained during this process.

IX. **New Business**

The first Reading of the 2017/2018 Budget was read. Mayor Busch stated the millage had not increased and stayed at 80. Mayor Busch stated that the projected budget for 2017/2018 is \$619,489.00. Council Member Mike Fanning made a motion to approve the first reading of the 2017/2018 budget. Council Member Milt Felder seconded the motion and all were in favor.

The next Council Meeting will be July 10, 2017 at 5:30PM.

X. **Executive Sessions**

Council Member Harold Void made a motion the go to executive session at 6:00PM and was seconded by Mike Fanning. All were in favor.

Council Member Harold Void made a motion to return to open session at 6:40pm and it was seconded by Council Member Mike Fanning. All were in favor. At that time Council Member Mike Fanning made a motion to purchase faux terracotta pots for Cleveland Street in the amount of \$5200.00. The motion was seconded by Milt Felder and all were in favor.

XI. **Adjournment**

Council Member Harold Void made a motion to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Kim Gidron. All were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 6:45pm.
