The October Ellore Town Council Meeting was held on Monday, October 14th at 5:30 in the Town Council Chambers.

All Town Council members were present: B. Brandenburg, K. Gidron, S. Parler, and C. Davis. Mayor Fanning presided.

Mayor Fanning welcomed everyone and led the invocation which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance

Councilman Davis made a motion to approve the Minutes from September Council Meeting. Councilman Brandenburg seconded the motion. All were in favor and minutes were approved as written.

A written Water Department Report was presented.

No public comments were received.

Police Chief Shawn Murphree presented the police report. Chief Murphree acknowledged the work of Lt. Austin Arant during his update. The Clerk of Court Report was present (see attachment)

The Town Clerk had the monthly financial report which was accepted by Council. Mayor Fanning provided information from the Clerk which included the success of recently held Trash-to-Treasures and comments provide in the attachment (see Clerk's Report October 2019). A reminder about the November 5th Election and the candidates was presented.

The Mayor's Report touched on the recent cleaning of Hwy 6 and the downtown thanking several individuals. All were reminded about Trunk-or-Treat.

Councilman Davis made a motion to go into Executive Session for contractual information. Councilman Gidron seconded the motion.

Council returned from Executive session with Councilman Brandenburg making a motion to come out of Executive Session which was seconded by Councilman Parler.

Councilman Davis made a motion to accept the bid from CAROLINA SPORT SURFACES INC. to resurface the Town of Ellore's tennis facility. The project would re-anchor net posts, correct fencing issues, resurface and paint the court and to transfer one tennis court into several pickle ball courts. Project bid was \$30,000. Councilman Parler seconded the motion to accept the bid. After a description of the project the motion to accept the bid passed unanimously.

Councilman Brandenburg reminded Council of the rescheduling of the November meeting due to Veteran's Day.

Councilman Gidron made a motion to Adjournment. Davis seconded the motion. All were in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
